Strathmore Secondary College Celebrates Outstanding VCE Results.

The Strathmore school community is delighted to congratulate the 2023 VCE graduates on their outstanding results. We recognise the time and effort expended by students, their teachers, and their families.

VCE scores are one measure of a school's success. We are delighted to be able to report that the college dux scored an ATAR of 99.70; followed by three of our students achieving scores of 98.70 or above.

Furthermore, 23 students achieved ATAR scores over 94 (10% of our cohort), 42 students scored an ATAR over 90 and 85 students scored an ATAR over 80.

One perfect study score of 50 was achieved.

Students who study at Strathmore Secondary College are indeed part of a learning community where everyone, regardless of their interests and passions, can experience success and achieve at the very highest level.

ENROLMENTS

Dear Parent/Guardian,

An important step in the enrolment process is the verification of details provided as part of the enrolment application. To prevent delays, please provide supporting documents as requested. (The most up to date requirements are available on the college website.)

Please provide a full birth certificate showing both parent names.

In the case of children born outside Australia who do not hold Permanent Residence Status – please provide their Passport and Visa.

Proof of Residence

The College gives priority to children whose residential address is within our designated area. Substantiation of actual residence within our enrolment boundary is required before an application will be considered.

This can be done by providing:

- One copy of either a current rate notice, contract of sale or a valid lease agreement from a real estate agent in the full name/s of the parent(s) or legal guardian(s), or a copy of the bond receipt should also be attached.
- In addition to the above, you will be required to provide additional documents to verify your child's permanent residence.

We cannot offer a place until you have actually moved into the property. Late arrivals in the zone will be waitlisted until all documents are provided.

Custody / Guardianship (if relevant)

In some instances, student or family names may have changed or there are differences between the student's name and that of the parents/guardians. In other instances, shared custody arrangements have been agreed and documented.

If either of these situations applies to you, please provide evidence of custody (Primary Care) and in cases of shared custody, a copy of the arrangements as ratified by the Child Support Agency.

In the interests of fairness and justice, please note that any enrolment offer based on false information will be withdrawn.

College Wardrobe

Students may choose items from the following uniform list

Jacket	Black/Green Soft Shell jacket with college crest, or 'puffer' jacket/vest with college crest.
Jumper	Black V neck with College crest
Dress	Green, black and grey chequered trans-seasonal dress
Pants	Charcoal grey, tailored or flat front
Skirt	Grey, black and green tartan skirt
Shorts	Plain dark grey
Shirt	White shirt with a collar, short or long sleeved, (not a polo shirt) or white high roll neck skivvy
Shoes	Plain black leather lace-up school shoes or black t-bars e.g. Clarks
Tights	Plain black tights
Socks	Plain white/dark grey/black socks
Accessories	Black scarf or school beanie (optional) School back-pack

Shorts	Sports shorts
Footwear	Runners
Swimwear	Bathers (one piece only), box swim shorts (no long board shorts)

Please note
